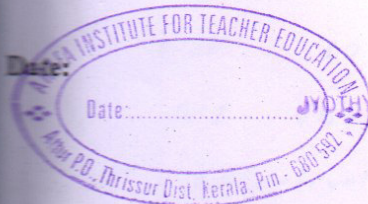

REFLECTIVE JOURNAL - 53

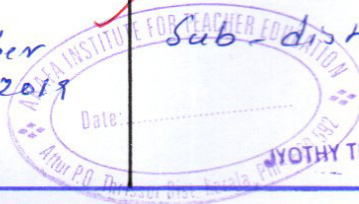
11th November 2019
